

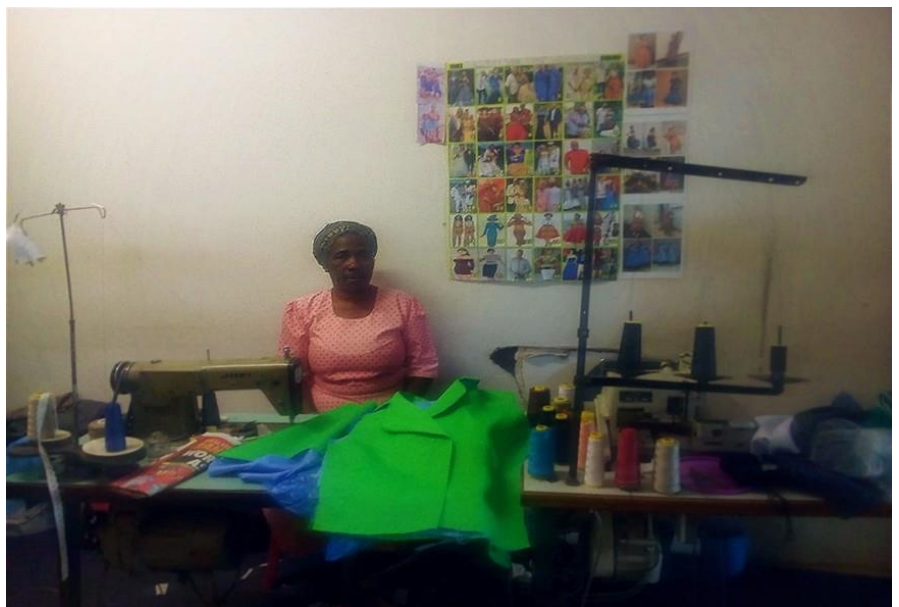
# Felm Savings Group Success Story

## Mrs Nhleko From Masincedane Savings Group

CREATE supports four savings groups in the Ugu district (uMzimkhulu and Rietvlei) - two from uMzimkhulu are called Siyaphambili (moving forward) and Inqababayomama (a tower of woman); - two from Rietvlei are called Masibambane (holding hands together) and Masincedane (helping each other).

Masincedane is an inclusive group (comprising people with disabilities, parents of children with disabilities' and non-disabled people i.e. relatives / carers of children and adults with disabilities). Mrs Nhleko is the aunt of a disabled boy. She has been very motivated and has achieved a lot since she started savings. She has set up a sewing business.

Mrs Nhleko's words of appreciation. "I would like to thank CREATE for introducing this idea of savings, with the money I saved lots of changes happened in my life. I managed to renovate my house, buying enough sewing material and paid up all the loans I had because I was in deep debt."



Because of all the things she has been able to achieve the people in her community approached her wanting to know the secret and when she explained everything to them about CREATE and they were interested in starting savings. Therefore in January 2020, three groups started in Harding. The total number of members in the three groups is sixty-nine (2 males and 67 females) - first group 20, second group 29 and third group 20.
